

## Family History Level 3 Self-Training

(Original March 2020)

1) Previously you learned how to use the “Planner” to invite others and to prepare short personalized FH Experiences using Ordinances Ready (OR). OR often leads to exciting discoveries of new/missing ancestors! We explored the first task discussed in the **“5 Simple Tasks for Latter-Day Saints to Try ...”** article within “Helper Resources”. We now move to the 2<sup>nd</sup> task.

2) Login to FS, > Help > Helper Resources > See All Articles. Scroll to and > the “5 Simple Tasks for Latter-Day Saints to Try ...” article. Scroll to and > on “Explore FH Activities”. Read the short blurb, > the reddish colored “FS Discovery Activities”. Scan the many activities. Consider how you might use these when preparing a personalized FH Experience – especially for children!

Let’s do it: Scroll to and > “The Year I was Born”, read the possible activities and then scroll to the bottom and > “What’s Special ...”, > explore these fun activities including “What was the Population...”. The world’s population when I was born was only 2.8 billion – how about when you were born??

3) Back arrow to the “5 simple Tasks...” article. At the bottom of task 2 > the blue “Search Discovery Experiences” rectangle. These fun activities are also accessible at the top of any screen page within FS by simply clicking “Activities”. Scan the 15 activities. > on and do the “Compare-a-Face” activity – how fun!!

Summary: These activities provide a wealth of opportunities to involve family members of all ages! Prayerfully consider their use when preparing personalized FH Experiences, especially for younger patrons! Great Job!
