Goal: Every ward member has a FamilySearch account & page. **Where to begin on FamilySearch.org is important with a separate handout divided into 10 areas for further clarification.**

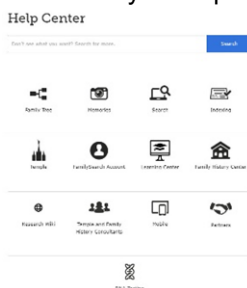
