John Kuzmich, Jr. Ph.D. and Roslyn Kuzmich will share their experiences of **connecting** with people across the globe on both sides of the veil through firesides and genealogy work. Brother and Sister Kuzmich have visited thirty-five countries in their search **to connect** the human race. Their mission statement is **“Let’s connect rather than evaporate.”** The couple has performed a dozen "Spoken Word–Music" firesides all over the world, including Warsaw, Poland; Ljubljana, Slovenia; Munich, Germany; Kiev, Ukraine; Moscow Russia; Budapest Hungary; Rome Italy, and Vienna, Austria. In addition, they are working with Family Search on algorithms and beta testing programs to extract every birth, marriage, and death record in **his** villages in Poland so that these records can be published for **the general public as** historical collections on Family Tree in Family Search.

Brother Kuzmich has learned much over his 50 years of actively pursuing temple and family history endeavors. He started genealogy from scratch as the only member of his extended family to be a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. While genealogical success has occurred slowly over time, the progress has also been astounding over time. The real miracle is how his entire family has been able to become actively engaged along with grandchildren with well-orchestrated extracting projects for future generations through the next 100 years to 2119 and beyond.

What makes this success even more measurable isn't just in seeking out deceased ancestors for hundreds and hundreds of years, but also in establishing projects about living relatives near and far that will be shared for future generations far into the future. This plan incorporates unique multimedia projects going far beyond indexing for both John's and Roslyn's extended families since 50% of his children's genealogy comes directly from Roslyn and not just from John's. This concentration and coordination of family roots on both sides of his children's ancestry is what makes families so important. This scope of archiving and restoring the extended family history for his children is what this phase of doing genealogy such a unifying eternal work because the living generations are equally as important as previous generations which presents a plan for a bright future for generations to come which correlates well to this fireside's theme: "Let's Connect Rather Than Evaporate!"
