Solutions for Challenging FamilySearch Research Topics

How many of you think that family history is important but research part of is not easy for you? Have you ever struggled to find a record for an ancestor through the normal search processes? This Level 8 training may help you to find these more elusive records. Did you know that some 70 to 80 % of FamilySearch's digitized records (records that have been converted into a digital form so that they can be processed by a computer) have not been indexed (meaning you will not get blue record hints nor can you as easily search for these records since they have not yet been indexed)? This Level 8 Self Training is to simply view the two attached videos (the two together are less than 30 minutes). The videos are an **introduction** to teach you how this vast majority of **unindexed** records within FamilySearch can also be searched. This training covers materials that as a Temple & Family History Consultants should at least be aware of so you will not be caught off guard should one of your patron's ask about challenging subjects. To any Minister of the Gospel, or any Officer Legally Authorized to Solemnize the Rite of Matrimony:
