1. Create a FamilySearch Account - www.familysearch.org
2. Sign into FamilySearch and view your FamilyTree.
3. Add living people to your FamilyTree.
4. Print a pedigree chart or a fan chart.
5. Select a person and look at their Person Page.
6. Scan some of your family photos.
7. Identify the people in the photos.
8. Find a relative that can help identify unknown family members in photos.
9. Add the scanned photos to FamilySearch Gallery.
10. Upload a Pic from Social Media [Instagram, Facebook, Google Photos]
11. Tag a photo on FamilySearch Memories.
12. Write a Story [it may be just a memory]
13. Complete a FamilySearch Recommended Task. 
14. Sign-up for Free Subscription Websites if you are a member of the church.
www.familysearch.org/campaign/partneraccess
15. Create a Tree in Ancestry.com from FamilySearch.
16. Review Shaky Leaf Hints in Ancestry.com.
17. Attach a Source from Ancestry.com to FamilySearch.
18. Record stories to upload to FamilySearch.
19. Download FamilySearch Apps for your phone or tablet.

20. Search for your Ancestor's in FamilySearch Records.
