Meet All Foothills Ward Temple & Family History Consultants with a Guided Tour of their Family Tree on FamilySearch.org via Screen Sharing on Your Computer and sharing the following information from their Family Tree. FamilySearch.org: a source of inspiration of all of us!

- 1. **Temple Ready:** Find distant relatives, Detail Page off your Family Tree, Exaltation page is Temple Ready. Because of COVID 19, the 90-day window to complete temple ordinances is locked until the temples go to Level 4 and those 90 days only begin then.
- 2. **Recommended Tasks** are directly coordinated with the Help Center for the Ordinances, Memories, etc. Indexing in the Help Center is linked directly to the editorial content.
- 3. Note when in the detail page and the expectation page for memories, ordinances, all headings are directly connected to the Helper Resource page.
- 4. If confused on how to best use the FamilySearch Help Center, call their extended technical support center at: 1-866-406-1830 and there are Church Family History Missionaries on-call 7 days a week from 8 am till 8 pm daily MDT except on Sundays from 1 pm to 8 pm. These missionaries are extremely knowledgeable and experienced so do take advantage of them.
