
## Ancestor: RootsTech Attendees Who Are Descendants From Close Ancestors

Wallace Carroll one of our distinguished Facebook followers has made an interesting discovery through one of his sons pertaining to RootTech 2021 attendee relationships. Because of my technology limitation in which I am unable to post it as is in Facebook, but through this link at <u>http://kuzmich4.com/RootsTech%202021/Wallace.jpg</u>, you can view it as a graphic for easier viewing and printing.

The result that through using your Family Tree app when logging into RootsTech, you can group all of your attending relatives into specific relationships instead of by just a listing by 1) All Relatives, 2) Maternal, 3) Paternal and now a fourth option with a button by Ancestor or Group by Ancestor. This discovery is particularly important for identifying close relatives. Hopefully, his description can be easy to follow on what to do in the Family Tree app for IOS and Android phones.

Wallace presently has 46,000+ relatives attending RootsTech 2021 and this discovery is critical for him in distinguishing who these close relatives are.



The web version has three buttons: All, Maternal and Paternal. The mobile version has a fourth button Ancestor or Group by Ancestor

For me it shows the 13 descendants of my parents, the 49 descendants of one set of grandparents, 25 from the other set of grandparents, 142 from one set of great grandparents, 69 from another, 1 from a third set and 1 from the fourth set of great grandparents. For me that was 300 people in 7 groups. For a friend, it was over 400 people in 30 groups. So your results will probably vary.
