

Yucatan Tour Lived Up To Its Expectations: *Evidence of Jesus Christ in Mesoamerica*

Retirement has its benefits besides slowing down in “old age” with physical ailments by being able to travel more fully even with two fully replaced knees. Below is the itinerary for 8 days in the Yucatan searching for evidence of Jesus Christ in Mesoamerica. We found them clearly on the Mayan Temples throughout the Yucatan as cited in the tour itinerary below and its companion map. The essential archaeological tool is to understand the signs and symbols included in the Mayan Temples throughout the Yucatan which further substantiates the **Book of Mormon** with the visitation of Jesus Christ after his crucifixion. The group tour photo was taken in Day 4 in Uxmal at a Mayan Temple which already has numerous signs and symbols plus other appropriate photos are also included as well with even more signs and symbols readily visible. An incredible spiritual experience to say the very least.

Below is the eight-day itinerary which certainly lived up to its high expectations.

Day One: Your adventure will begin at the Fairfield Inn & Suites Cancun Airport. We will have a hotel room reserved for you and you can check in as early as 3:00 p.m. Dinner is on your own. Your Tour will begin that evening at 7:30 p.m. with a “meet and greet” at the Hotel. At this orientation meeting you will receive tour materials and a special presentation on **Signs and Symbols**, which will be critically important information for your tour experience.

Day Two: After breakfast we will board our tour bus at 9:00 a.m. for a two-hour drive to **EK’ BALAM**, a city heavily influenced by three immortals, known as the Three Brothers. This Book of Mormon era city sat in a strategic location that protected the great salt beds of the Yucatan. The city was eventually abandoned but the inhabitants left behind significant evidence of their belief in a God named Itzamna, who was their Creator, and He was also the Son of the great Father God. We will be in a remote area and there will be no place for us to stop for a lunch. We suggest you bring your favorite snacks and we will also have some

light snacks and water on the bus. After leaving EK' BALAM we will travel to the town of Piste, just outside of Chichen Itza, where we will have an early dinner and spend the night in an archaeological villa.

Day Three: After an early breakfast, we will spend 3-4 hours in **CHICHEN ITZA**, exploring a city that houses one of the New Seven Wonders of the World as well as the great training ground that was established by the *Three Brothers*, to train Halach Uinics, or the True Men, to serve as both the temporal and spiritual leaders of their communities. These Halach Uinics were taught about Itzamna, the one true god, who came down out of Heaven to conquer the monsters of death and hell. After leaving Chichen Itza, We will have lunch en route to Uxmal, one of the most beautiful Mayan cities ever built. In the late afternoon we will stop for 2 hours to visit the **Choco Story**. This is a combination interpretive museum and wild animal shelter, where you will see how the Maya made paper, medicines and chocolate. You can also attend a Mayan ceremony and a chocolate making demonstration where you can drink chocolate made the way the ancient people of the Book of Mormon did. You will also be able to hand-feed some of the wild animals that have been rescued. We will then check in at our Hotel for dinner.

Day Four: After an early breakfast, we will visit the great city of **UXMAL**. This city was heavily influenced by the *Three Brothers* and has a magnificent temple complex, dedicated to Itzamna, the person we would think of as Christ. At Noon, we will have lunch en route to **LABNA**, where we will see ancient temples that testify of Itzamna and His role as the great mediator between God, the Father, and Man. We then travel to the ancient city of **KABAH** where you will see ancient Mayan roads and arches and ancient depictions of Mayan warfare with two distinct armies fighting each other, with one army wearing armor and the other just loin cloths. We end the day back at our Hotel for dinner and relaxation time.

Day Five: After an early breakfast we will have a long bus ride to the great city of **BECAN** where you will see on the side of a Book of Mormon era temple the depiction of Itzamna, or Christ, resurrected and coming out of the mouth of death and hell with the breath of life in His nostrils. We will spend the night next to Becan, surrounded by the jungle, at the Eco Village.

Day Six: We will have an early departure and eat breakfast on the bus, en route to **KOHUNLICH**, a city where the last thing the king or governor saw each night was the setting sun lighting up the face of Itzamna and His resurrection from the dead. We will then travel on to **TULUM**, where we will visit temples that were rebuilt under the direction of the *Three Brothers*, which testified of Itzamna and His Father. You will also learn about the unique connection Joseph Smith had with this city. We will then travel to our hotel in Playa del Carmen, where we will spend the next two nights. You will enjoy a special dinner at an exceptional Italian restaurant.

Day Seven: Today we will visit one of the **top cultural parks in all of Mexico**. You will be able to walk through a world class aviary, butterfly pavilion and float down an underground river through ancient Mayan ruins. During the day you can choose from dozens of wildlife exhibits, aquariums, live horse shows, a Mayan village and many other activities that highlight the wonders of the Mayan world. In the evening, you will be summoned by Mayan warriors to your **VIP Dinner**, where you will be seated at courtside to enjoy the best cultural show in Mexico. With more than 300 artists on stage, you will be taken on a spectacular journey, through the medium of music and acting, from the culture of the early Maya, through the initial encounter between the Maya and the Spanish conquistadors and concluding with the current day cultural traditions and dances of Mexico. This will be a full day experience that you will never forget, from 9am to 9pm.

Day Eight: Depending on COVID restrictions and airport requirements that are in place on the day of your departure, there may or may not be time for shopping in Playa del Carmen before returning to the airport in Cancun to catch your flight home.
